3- Methods for preservation of aquatic fungi.

4- Identification of aquatic fungi:

- a- By conventional methods.
- b- By molecular techniques (with special reference to phylogeny).

5- Biological and environmental role of aquatic fungi:

- a- Biodegradation of wastes.
- b- Bioremediation of polluted sites.
- c- Biocontrol of harmful insects and nematodes.
- d- Natural products of aquatic fungi.
- e- Plant and animal diseases caused by aquatic fungi.
